Whips will be sold from January. During March, spare stock plants will be for sale - please ask if interested. Standards and fuchsia baskets will be ready from 5<sup>th</sup> May. Prices throughout will depend on size. Larger plants may be available throughout the season - please ask.

From June 2nd until July 1st - there will be displays of fuchsias in flower - please come and have browse and get ideas for next year. It is an unbeatable opportunity to see fuchsias that you will not see at shows etc.

It is always possible that cultivars not shown in the catalogue, will be held on the nursery, please ask!

### **New Cultivars**

This year we are introducing quite a number of exciting new cultivars - they all are special! We are grateful to the hybridisers for letting us introduce them.

**Jill Holloway** (Kimberley 2007) has flowers that are Triphylla like with a long tube. The flowers are a deep pink with a hint of orange. The leaves also suggest that there is a lot of triphylla in its parentage. It will be ideal for pots and tubs.

**Leslie Drew** (Drew 2007) A delightful fuchsia with an almost white tube and sepals and blue to violet corolla. It is both floriferous and a strong grower.

**Limelight** (Weston 2007) As the name suggests Limelight has lovely lime coloured foliage which really make a lovely contrast with the flowers. The blooms are small and profuse! The tube and sepals are creamy white and the petals are pale violet. A nice easy fuchsia to grow!

**Mrs Lee Belton** (Morrison 2007) This is a delightful encliandra with lovely small flowers that are less than 1cm long! The tube and sepals are pale orange and the petals are a rich orange. It is strong grower and has proved hardy in the north of England.

**Toby Foreman** (Waving 2007) Pete Waving seems to have produced yet another good single flowered fuchsia that could well have show potential. The tube and sepals are deep rose and the petals reflex right back. The petals are creamy white with a hint of pink.

PROCUMBENS VAR. WIRRAL (Breary 1996) (S) T greenish yellow. S green tipped purple. No corolla. Bright blue pollen. Foliage shades of green, silver and pink.

SPLENDENS (Zuccarini 1832) (S) T rose and pinched. S green. C pale green Flowers predominantly in the spring!
